Start good and slow. Won easily; second and third driving. The Finn was rated in front under slight restraint while setting a great pace and drew away in the stretch to win under restraint. Half Rock saved ground on all the turns and, responding gamely to punishment, easily disposed of Pebbles in the stretch. Pebbles appeared to climb during the running and tired badly when the final drive came.
