Start good and slow. Won easily; second and third driving. Grey Lag, showing great improvement over his last race, came fast when entering the stretch and, racing into the lead, was under slight restraint through the last eighth. Sporting Blood seemed to tire on the far turn when called on, but closed up gradually under vigorous riding. Leonardo II. displayed great speed and set a fast early pace, but tired badly in the stretch drive. Quecreek was badly outrun and beaten off at the end.
