Start good and slow. Won easily; second and third same. Gallant Fox was rushed into the lead at the start, was rated along under restraint and, given a breathing spell passing the half-mile post and again on the far turn, drew away when called upon and then came wide entering the stretch, finishing with speed in reserve. Whichone was taken under restraint in the early stages, but did not stride freely in the greasy going, responded when called upon on the far turn and finished gamely on the inside of the winner. Questionnaire, close up throughout, saved much ground turning for home, but could not menace the leaders. Swinfield made a determined effort when called upon, but quit badly and was eased up at the end.
