Start good out of machine. Won easily; second and third driving. Twenty Grand, under steady restraint in the early running, moved up quickly midway of the backstretch, was taken in hand again and, going around the leaders on the far turn, took the lead on the stretch turn and drew away, winning with speed to spare. Sun Meadow, closest to the pace and under restraint, challenged gamely on the far turn and held on well under pressure to outlast Jamestown. The latter set the pace under restraint to the stretch turn, where he failed to withstand the challenge of Twenty Grand and, tiring badly, was outgamed for second place in the final stride.
