Start good and slow. Won driving; second and third same. HURRYOFF improved his position steadily and, going to the outside of the leaders, finished gamely. Nimbus worked his way up steadily, but impeded Union at the eighth post and tired at the finish. Union showed a good performance, came through on the inside in the stretch, but was bothered by Nimbus. The Darb was taken back on the far turn and, blocked, was forced to go to the outside and moved into command with a rush, then quit. Sun Apollo set a fast pace, but tired badly. Pompoleon quit under pressure. Dark Winter quit when called upon. Repaid was outrun. Utopian was pulled up in the stretch.
