IN GATE AT 5.30. OFF AT 5.30 EASTERN DAYLIGHT TIME. Start good. Won handily.

DAMASCUS, in hand and saving ground to the mile moved up fast on the outside leaving the upper turn, was set down hard in the early stretch and, after taking command from COOL RECEPTION, drew clear while under mild urging COOL RECEPTION, away alertly, took command from PRINKIPO after three quarters mile, held on gamely until inside the stretch but was unable to withstand DAMASCUS, then came back decidedly lame, the result of a broken right cannon bone. GENTLEMAN JAMES, far back, until the stretch, finished determinedly in a courageous performance. PROUD CLARION, reserved and saving ground while racing within striking distance of the leaders to the mile, moved up boldly approaching the stretch but faltered during the drive. FAVORABLE TURN had early speed but failed to stay. GAYLORD'S FEATHER lacked early foot and was never dangerous. REASON TO HAIL, steadied when caught in tight quarters after a mile, dropped out of serious contention during the stretch run. BLASTING CHARGE, never prominent had no mishap. PRINKIPO began alertly but stopped before going a mile.
