At any time prior to Closing, Thursday, June 6, 1991, horses may be nominated to The Belmont Stakes upon payment of a supplementary fee of \$50,000 to The New York Racing Association Inc. The added money and all fees to be divided 60% to the winner, 22% to second, 12% to third and 6% to fourth. Colts and Geldings, 126 lbs.; Fillies, 121 lbs.

HANSEL, allowed to follow the early leaders while racing well out in the track, reached even terms with CORPORATE REPORT with five furlongs remaining, edged clear approaching the stretch and, after drawing away through the upper stretch, lasted over STRIKE THE GOLD while drifting out badly under pressure. STRIKE THE GOLD, unhurried while outrun into the backstretch, commenced to rally while racing widest nearing the far turn. He remained outside the four leaders into the stretch and finished strongly while continuing very wide. MANE MINISTER, never far back while racing well out in the track, rallied four wide nearing the stretch and finished with good energy. CORPORATE REPORT brushed with QUINTANA after the start, then went right after ANOTHER REVIEW. He headed that rival before going a half, held on well to the stretch while saving ground and tired. SCAN, within easy striking distance early, moved up outside CORPORATE REPORT and HANSEL nearing the end of the backstretch, remained a factor until near the stretch and gave way. QUINTANA brushed with CORPORATE REPORT after the start, raced wide throughout and failed to reach serious contention. LOST MOUNTAIN was always outrun. SMOOTH PERFORMANCE moved within striking distance approaching the end of the backstretch, then tired badly. SUBORDINATED DEBT, wide into the backstretch, was finished before going a mile. GREEN ALLIGATOR, eased back after the start, moved up inside horses entering the backstretch but lacked a further response. ANOTHER REVIEW, sent to the front along the inside early, showed speed into the backstretch while saving ground, stopped suddenly before going six furlongs and was eased when unable to keep up.
